THE FOLLOWING IS REQUIRED BEFORE YOUR STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND BAND CAMP:

- ✓ Student Physical Packet turned in: Physical completed by a physician, Medical Release/Excursion Form filled out and signed by a parent. The OTC (Over the Counter Prescription Medication Form) as well as a current picture of the student.
- ✓ \$80 Camp Fee must be paid in full or you must have made payment arrangements with the Treasurer.

WHAT TO BRING ON A DAILY BASIS?

- Insulated Blue Water Thermos or Camel Water Pack (min. 1 quart capacity)
Mandatory Please bring your thermos or camel pack filled with water from home.
- Full Stomach – You need to eat breakfast before you come to rehearsal. Starbucks, Red Bull or Monster Drinks is not an appropriate breakfast.
- Sunscreen, and Chapstick. Mandatory
- Band Aid Blister block for feet, toes and fingers
- Small back pack to carry: sunscreen, chapstick, music, and other necessities for the day.
- 2 mechanical pencils, dot books (3x5 spiral index cards book), shoe string for dot book, at least 5 good reeds (winds only), BERP device (brass only), 1 & 1/2 inch black 3 ring binder and 50 plastic page savers (winds, brass, percussion only), instrument, valve oil and any other necessary musical supplies.

BAND CAMP DISCIPLINE POLICY

A safe and friendly atmosphere is the responsibility of all students, volunteers and staff at ENHS. You and your child should understand that while participating at camp, the staff is in charge. Your child should be aware that any rules and/or instructions that are made by a staff member or camp volunteer are to be respected. In the unlikely event that there is a disciplinary problem that cannot be resolved, the parent will be notified and expected to pick up their student immediately. The student will not be allowed to return to camp and no refund will be given.

CAMP RULES

- Profanity/disrespect against fellow students, staff or volunteers will not be tolerated.

- No drugs, alcohol, cigarettes, fireworks, firearms, knives or other weapons of any kind will be permitted. Zero Tolerance
- Rehearsal attire should be white t-shirt/tank top, athletic shorts, tennis shoes and socks. Ladies, we please no visible bra straps. (See Below)
- Students are expected to be on time for all activities, practices, meetings and meals.
- Students will be held financially responsible for destruction or loss of equipment as well as damage or defacing buildings and other facilities.
- We are not responsible for any lost or stolen property. It is each individual's responsibility to keep track of his/her personal property. All items must be labeled with the student's name.
- Any public display of affection on the part of students will not be permitted. This includes holding hands.
- All students will be responsible for daily cleanup. A different section will be assigned to clean the cafeteria after every meal and all students will be expected to do their "Fair Share" of the work.
- All trash should be placed in waste cans.
- Parents are encouraged to visit during evening rehearsals throughout the week. The evening rehearsals will more enjoyable to watch, but you may come at any time for any rehearsal.
- Students will be Required to turn in their cell phones off during rehearsal. If it goes off during rehearsal, we will take it.
- Students who drive to camp will not be allowed to go to their car during the day. They will need to get everything out of it that they will need for the day.
- Every student will be expected to clean up after themselves

DRESS CODE

- *Clothing should be comfortable and appropriate.
- * Athletic shoes and socks must be worn at all times
- *You will be required to wear a White T-Shirt/Tank Top during every rehearsal. Ladies, no visible bra straps, please fix this or we will provide appropriate clothing for you.
- *No "short" shorts or shorts with holes. Cotton or mesh shorts are suggested for maximum comfort. Please do not wear jean or thick heavy shorts.
- *Everyone should bring a hat/ball cap during all outside rehearsals.
- *No clothing with suggestive words or designs or with slogans advertising alcohol or cigarettes.
